Venue access & Parking Instructions

Testing

Please register at KNE Reception before setting up and the team will advise on the best location and which pitlane will be getting used for that session. Should you wish to stay overnight, prior to, or after the session please inform KNE 24 hours before arrival on 0191 5214050.

Race Weekends

Paddock bays can be booked prior to events with or with out electric using the form on https://wardenlawmotorsports.com/venue-plans/ Please note paddock bays will be allocated to ensure maximum efficiency of the paddock area. Please only book what you require and be considerate of space for others. No working vehicles (caravans, cars motorhomes etc are not allowed in the main paddock)

Please note the standard main gates are locked between 8pm-8am Monday-Thursday and 8pm-8am Friday – Sunday. This will differ for events.

Access times to the venue for race events will depend on the weekends itinerary and will be released in final instructions one week prior to the event

- Under no circumstances is it permitted to park on the main road or on the grass/road
 outside the main gate. Please find alternative parking if you arrive at a time when the gate
 is closed. On race weekends there will be limited space on the access road to park until
 gates open.
- Should you need to drop-off items you will be required to leave your contact details, i.e., name and contact number with the Paddock Official. You will be required to then remove your vehicle to an assigned parking area, should any person refuse, this will be reported to the event officials, and you will risk disqualification.
- There is strictly no parking on access roads as these MUST be kept clear for emergency vehicles. Previous years has seen the road blocked by inconsiderate parking. Anyone found to be parking in restricted areas risk being disqualified from the meeting or having their associated driver/team excluded.
- Electrical hook up is available in the Main Paddock and West Paddock @ £15 per day. There
 is limited hook up in the overnight stay area which is available on a first come basis.
 The hookups are 16amp and anyone found to be splitting supply, overloading the socket or
 using non-waterproof connections will have their supply removed and connections
 confiscated without refund.

Paddock Areas

- Smoking & Vaping is prohibited within the Parc Ferme, Dummy Grid, Scrutineering & Tyre Bay
- Engines must not be run before 09:00 or after 18:00. Running of engines in the paddock within this time is restricted to 10 seconds.
- Competitors & Teams are responsible for removal of all waste from their paddock area including but not limited to tyres & fuel drums/cans. Domestic rubbish must be placed in the bins provided. Please do not place non compactable scrap in the bins (i.e. Axles etc)
- Competitors and Teams must ensure all trailing cables are suitably covered with cableprotection matts or other suitable means to ensure there are no tripping hazards.
- The maximum speed limit for the paddock area is **5mph.**
- All access lanes in the paddock area must always be kept clear in case of the need foremergency vehicle access.
- Scooters (including electric scooters), pit bikes, push bikes, model cars, roller skates, skateboards, hoverboards etc. or ball games are not permitted within the confines of the track, surrounding enclosures, paddock areas nor on the approach road to the circuit at any time. Anyone breeching the above may be reported to the stewards of the meeting or official in charge of the testing session (with the exception of official vehicles) and may be fined £100 for each offence or have the item confiscated.
- Children should be accompanied by an adult at all times in the paddock.
- Parent/Guardians are responsible for the behaviour and whereabouts of their children at all times.
- Children are not permitted to play on the circuit at anytime. There is an extensive amount of lighting, timing, and other electronic equipment on track, that if damaged will put the meeting at risk.
- Vehicles may only be driven in the pits by a person holding that appropriate RTA licence.
- All generators in the paddock must be turned off by 10pm.
- Competitors must have present a fire extinguisher complying with 2024 Karting Yearbook B.12 at all times whilst in the paddock
- Dogs will be allowed in the paddock area but must always be on a lead. **Dogs are not** allowed on the track at any time.
- Motorhome and Caravan waste must only be emptied into the dedicated elsan point by reception.
- Any person found to be bringing the Club into disrepute or damaging any area
 of the paddock or track will be subject to the disciplinary procedures of the
 organising club. PLEASE RESPECT THE VENUE AT ALL TIMES

There will be a KNE member of staff on duty throughout the night (10pm-8am) and may be contacted via the office next to the briefing room in an emergency. All other paddock enquiries should be directed to the KNE reception.
