

Race Weekend Paddock Regulations 2025 v1.0

Welcome to Warden Law! we have seen great investment both financially and physical over the last few years to ensure you have a top rate facility to enjoy. Please respect the circuit and the measures put in place, to ensure that we continue to grow and improve the circuit for years to come.

Gate Access Times (May be specific to event final instructions)

Thursday	10.00-22.00
Friday	07.00-22.00
Saturday	07.00-22.00
Sunday	07.00-20.00

There is strictly no vehicle access outside of these times, except in an emergency. Late arrivals may park to the left-hand side of the access road and use the pedestrian gate to access facilities. Please ensure there is sufficient room for emergency vehicles to pass.

The below regulations are for your safety and comfort during your visit and any competitor not abiding to them could be asked to leave at any time without refund.

- 1) Under no circumstances is it permitted to park on the main road or on the grass/road outside the main gate. Please find alternative parking if you arrive at a time when the gate is closed.
- 2) Access roads must be kept clear at all times to allow access for emergency vehicles. Parking in prohibited areas may cause the meeting to be stopped and your removal from the site without refund.
- 3) Paddock bays can be booked via the online form; by booking a bay you agree to these regulations and costs associated with the booking.
- 4) Paddock bays will be allocated on a booking basis and will be arranged for maximum efficiency. We will always endeavour to book you in the zone and bay type requested.
- 5) The hook ups are 16 amps, and anyone found to be splitting supply, overloading sockets, or using non waterproof connections will have their supply removed and connections confiscated without refund. Strictly NO EV Charging from these points.
- 6) MOTORHOMES & CARAVANS if you are bringing a motorhome or caravan and it is NOT BEING USED TO RUN YOUR KART OUT OF, i.e. not a working vehicle, it must be parked to the rear of the West Paddock or Upper West Paddock. If it is found during the event that a non-working motorhome or caravan is in the main/west paddocks, WLKC reserves the right to revoke any future paddock requests.
- 7) GROUND SHEETS To protect the paddock tarmac, ground sheets are mandatory in all awnings/pop up's in tarmac bays. Any karts in these areas, not in an awning, i.e. side of a van, must have a minimum of a floor mat that fits underneath the working area.
- 8) Drilling of the tarmac is prohibited without the express permission of circuit management.
- 9) Smoking and vaping are prohibited in restricted areas.
- 10) Kart engines must not be run before 09.00 or after 1800. Running of engines within this time is restricted to the area behind the assembly area and for a maximum of 5 seconds or as per championship regulations.
- 11) Competitors and Teams are responsible for removal of all waste from their paddock area including but limited to tyres & fuel/oil cans/drums. Domestic waste must be placed in the bins provided. **Please do not place scrap (ie axles) in the bins,** just place beside for collection. Anyone caught contravening this rule will be fined £500.
- 12) Competitors and teams must ensure all trailing cables are covered with cable protection mats or other suitable means to reduce the risk of trips.
- 13) The maximum speed limit for the paddock area is **5mph.**
- 14) Scooters (including electric scooters), pit bikes, push bikes, model cars, roller skates, skateboards, hoverboards etc or ball games are not permitted within the confines of the track, surrounding enclosures, paddock areas nor on access roads at any time.



- 15) Anyone in breach of the above may be reported to the stewards of the meeting or official in charge of the event, be fined £100 per offence and/or have the item confiscated.
- 16) Children should be accompanied by an adult at all times in the paddock.
- 17) The circuit, paddock and surrounding areas are not a playground & parent/guardians are responsible for the behaviour and whereabouts of their children at all times. There is an extensive amount of lighting, timing and other event equipment on track and surrounding areas, which if damaged will put the event at risk.
- 18) Vehicles may only be driven in the paddock by a person holding a relevant RTA licence.
- 19) All generators must be turned off by 10pm.
- 20) Competitors must have present, a fire extinguisher complying with 2025 MSUK National Competition Rules, available at the front of their bay at all times.
- 21) When working on karts there must be a mat beneath the stand to protect the tarmac.
- 22) Dogs will be allowed in the paddock and spectating areas but must be on a lead. Please clean up after them. **Dogs are not allowed on the track at any time.**
- 23) Motorhome and caravan waste must only be emptied into the dedicated elsan point and not into the toilets.
- 24) We have a zero-tolerance policy on any abusive or threatening behaviour or language to any of our officials or KNE/WLKC team members.
- 25) Any person brining the club or venue into disrepute or damaging any area of the paddock or track will be subject to the disciplinary procedures of the organiser or venue.
- 26) Notices are placed round the paddock with emergency information displayed. The circuit office can be contacted in an emergency on
