



## Your visit to Warden Law

Please find some information below to make your stay at Warden Law a safe and enjoyable one.

Gate access times are **7am-10pm**. Please note there is strictly no vehicle access outside of these times except in an emergency.

### Fire Safety:

- No open fires, fire pits allowed anywhere on site
- Please leave a minimum of 6 metres between sleeping units
- Ensure all electrical equipment is of good condition and all outdoor cables and connections are weatherproof
- Fire Points & Assembly Points are detailed on the map overleaf
- In event of a fire raise the alarm and call 999 – Karting North East SR3 2PR

### General Safety

- Children should be accompanied by an adult at all times in the paddock.
- **The circuit, paddock and surrounding areas are not a playground** & parent/guardians are responsible for the behaviour and whereabouts of their children at all times. There is an extensive amount of lighting, timing and other event equipment on track and surrounding areas, which if damaged will put the event at risk.
- The site speed limit is 5mph
- Scooters (including electric scooters), pit bikes, push bikes, model cars, roller skates, skateboards, hoverboards etc or ball games are not permitted within the confines of the track, surrounding enclosures, paddock areas nor on access roads at any time.
- The toilets and showers are open 24 hours a day, however, may be closed if abused or vandalised
- Dogs must be kept on leads and are not allowed on the track at any time. There is a nature reserve to the South side of the site which is ideal for dog walks
- Refuse points are located around the site please use the correct recycling bin. Strictly no tyres, fuels/oils to be deposited or left on site. Leave scrap metal beside bins.
